## ❖ Notes

- Discrete amplification of strings is left to the judgment of the performers;
- The organ registration is generic and left to the discretion of the performer and the possibilities of the instrument;
- It is recommended to seat euphoniums with horns, away from trumpets and trombones;
- Three different symbols of fermata do indicate rests of different length;
- The symphony comes in 2 versions; the second comprises a cadenza for organ and claves to be inserted at second bar of rehearsal figure 44.

## ❖ Reference to 7 mathematicians:

- Pythagoras of Samos [569 BC – 475 BC];
- Diophantus of Alexandria [200 – 284] developed Pythagoras’ theory on prime numbers;
- l’Abbé Pierre de Fermat [1601 – 1665] read the ‘Arithmetique’ by Diophantus which was published again around 1621. In his last papers, De Fermat left a side note indicating that, quote “he discovered an admirable prove of this proposition, too small to be contained in this margin”;
- Leonhard Euler [1707 – 1783], brilliant Swiss mathematician, professor in St Petersburg at the time of Empress Catherine of Russia, attempted to solve Fermat’s last theorem;
- Joseph-Louis Lagrange [1736 – 1813] and Bernhard Riemann [1826 – 1866] attempted to solve Fermat’s last theorem;
- Andrew John Wiles [1953 – ], Chair Department of Mathematics of Princeton University solved Fermat’s last theorem.

❖ **Programme notes**

Robert Casteels' Symphony No. 2 is in one movement of 24 minutes. Its unitary form was sculpted as its content was being developed, rather than being governed by any preconceived plan of an overall structure. The acoustical possibilities of each instrument dictated the choice of the diverse instrumentation. The 70-strong orchestra includes: choir, organ, piano, bowed strings, plucked strings (harp, harpsichord, pipa, yangqin, electric and acoustic guitars), complete clarinet family (from piccolo to contralto and contrabass clarinets), complete flute family (from 4 piccolos to alto and bass flute), and ensemble of tubas.

Robert drew his inspiration for Symphony No. 2 partly from a fascination with numbers and partly from 2 European songs. He does not adhere to the common belief that numbers and pleasure are antithetical; in fact, to him, numbers contain endless possibilities for inspiration, metamorphoses and dreams. In times when obsession with immediate financial gratification seems to be prevalent, Robert admires scientists and mathematicians who dedicate their entire life to research that benefits future generations, as well as societies that enable this research to take place.

In this Symphony No. 2, the number 7 takes on a seminal significance. This mathematical framework contrasts with dreamy reminiscences of an art song and the refreshing contrast of a humorous ditty. At first the sung text refers to 7 mathematicians all associated with solving the same enigma. Thereafter, the choir alternates between the teasing “fury fury” and Pierre de Fermat’s last theorem that was recently elucidated by Andrew Wiles.

Symphony No. 2 was commissioned by and for the Singapore Arts Festival 2006.


