Performance notes

An orchestra practising on stage before the beginning of the concert produces an extraordinarily complex and whirling soundscape, like a painting by Jackson Pollock. Here and there one can recognise snippets. This chaos is meaningful because it has unity in purpose and content.

From this chaos emerges the tuning. The sound of an orchestra tuning always moves me, whether I am backstage waiting as a conductor or listening in the audience. The mutiple and disparate practising voices zoom onto a single pitch. More than just enabling tuning, this one pitch creates organic unity and mental focus with the single aim to make music with the best minds and hearts.

No explanation should be given to the audience prior to the performance of this concert overture. A verbal explanation may be given after the performance of "Musings".

Players practice with conviction. The tuning procedure is real.
